

## Showing Your Travel Photography

- 1) Narrow your subject focus ex. Tennessee to Tailgate Party
- 2) Tell a story, beginning, middle, and an end
- 3) Arrange photos based on content or time
- 4) Transitions – good and bad
- 5) Keep it short-
  - Q) how many images should be in a presentation
  - A) as many images as it takes to tell your story

*Point of View* (POV). The author must be able to convey how they see the world in the most comprehensive and concise way.
- 6) Music – ex from period
- 7) Commentary or Not - Have something interesting prepared to say about each image, but be prepared to say nothing and let the viewer appreciate the work on its own merit if that is their viewing style.
- 8) Graphics, titles, credits
- 9) Written Travelog to support photos, comment function in camera, milestone photos, geotagging
- 10) Edit while you travel
- 11) Set the local time on the camera
